Dear Parents

Pupils after school

I am really concerned about the number of children who hang around the school premises for hours after the end of the school day. The teachers cannot be held responsible for supervising the children, as we are occupied elsewhere with extra-mural activities. The children become bored and get up to mischief and that's when accidents happen. We understand the difficult position that working parents are in, because we are working parents too. I appeal to you to ensure that your child is collected within half an hour of the end of the school day and are not left unsupervised for long periods of time whilst waiting to be fetched. Alternately, your child should be at an extra-mural activity or enrolled at aftercare. We do not want a tragedy to happen before we all sit up and take note of the seriousness of the situation. A reminder too, that our aftercare will accept children on a short term, or single day basis. The fee is R60 half day and R80 full day.

This year Ascension Day takes place on Thursday 29 May and Groote Schuur Primary School will be closed for the day. Please make the necessary arrangements for your children.


